GETTING THE BIG EVENT IN PRINT

Thank you for making *The Tampa Tribune* part of your special day. Special Occasions announcements appear in *The Tampa Tribune's* Sunday Baylife & Travel section. Deadline is Monday at noon (unless there is a holiday) for the following Sunday. Your announcement will be scheduled for the next available publication date unless a date is specified.

When submitting the information you would like included in the announcement,

an address, home telephone number and daytime telephone number and e-mail address should be included.

Announcements must be paid in advance of publication. American Express, Discover, MasterCard, Visa, cash, check or money order are acceptable forms of payment. For further information, please call (813) 259-8050.



ABOUT YOUR PHOTOGRAPH

Professional photographs are frequently copyrighted. It is the advertiser's responsibility to obtain a copyright release prior to publication.

Photographs should be professional quality prints.

A veil should not obscure the bride's face. For best reproduction, choose a clear, sharp focus photo, either color or black and white, and without a heavily textured surface. Look for good contrast. A light background usually will reproduce better.

Original photographs may be used, or photos may be emailed. If a photo is e-mailed or sent to us on a disc, please make sure the photo is at least 200 dpi. If your digital photo is 72 dpi, please do not change the resolution or size of the photo for us.

We reserve the right to refuse photos that are deemed to be of poor quality or poor taste and

the right to crop photos as necessary. Photos will not be altered unless there are obvious marks or creases that would interfere with the reproduction of the photo in the newspaper. We cannot alter a person's physical attributes in the form of a touch-up.

Photographs are scanned, cropped, enlarged or reduced via computer here at *The Tampa Tribune*. Do not cut the photo yourself. We tone all photos here to meet our newsprint specifications.

Please identify the back of your photo with a label or write lightly in pencil. Do not bear down with a ball point pen (it will show up in the scanned image and reproduce in the newspaper). Please do not use paperclips, as they bend and scratch the photos.

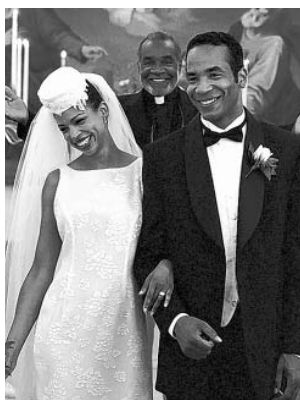

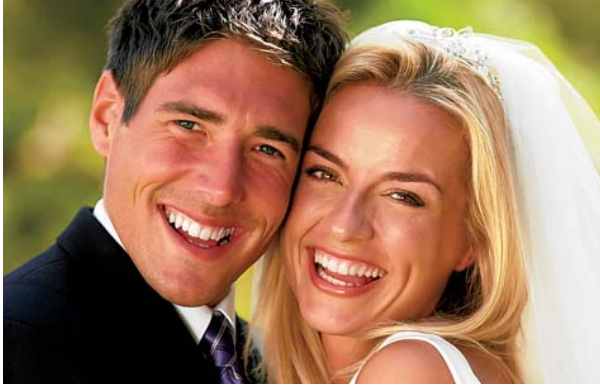
